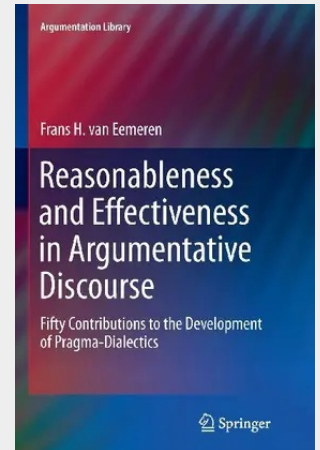


Reasonableness and Effectiveness in Argumentative Discourse
