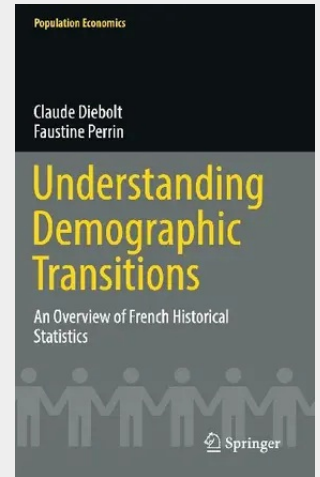


Understanding Demographic Transitions
