

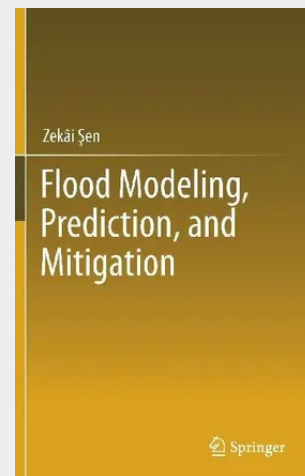
Flood Modeling, Prediction and Mitigation
