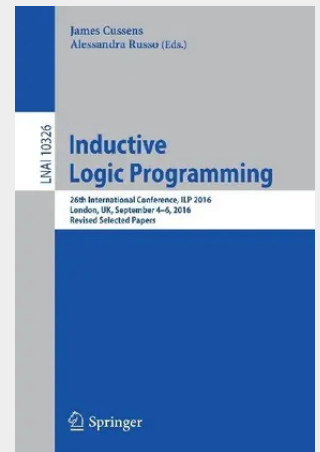


Inductive Logic Programming
