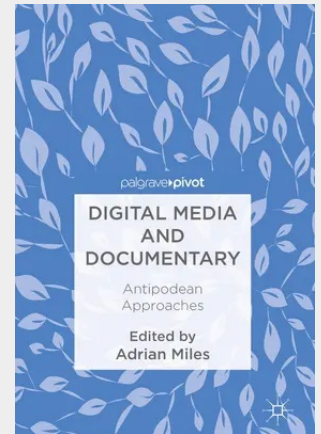


Digital Media and Documentary
