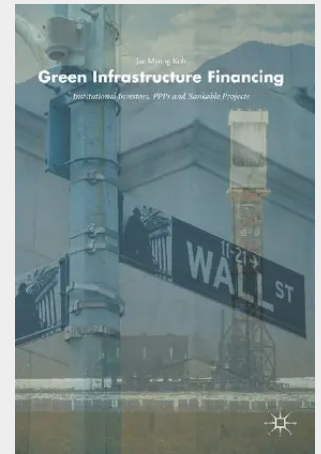


Green Infrastructure Financing
