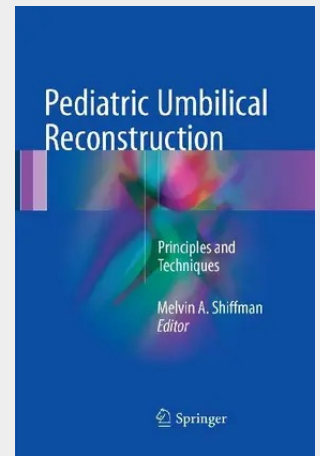


Pediatric Umbilical Reconstruction
