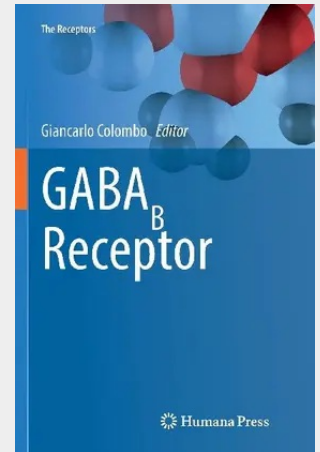


GABAB Receptor
