

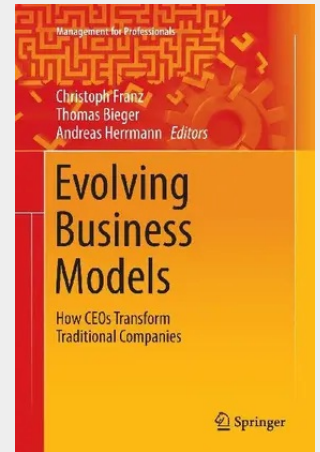
Evolving Business Models
