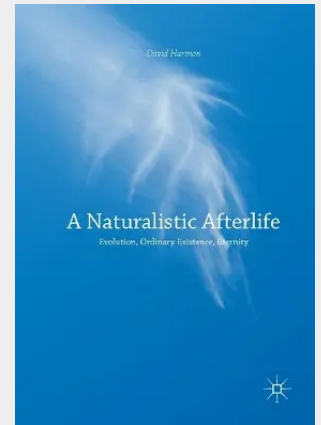


Harmon
