

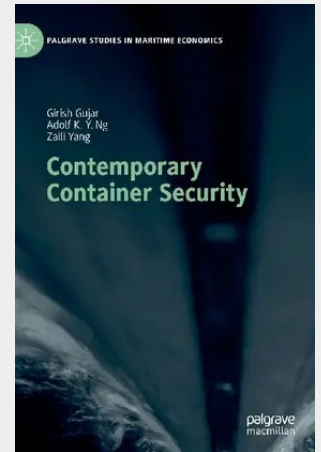
Contemporary Container Security
