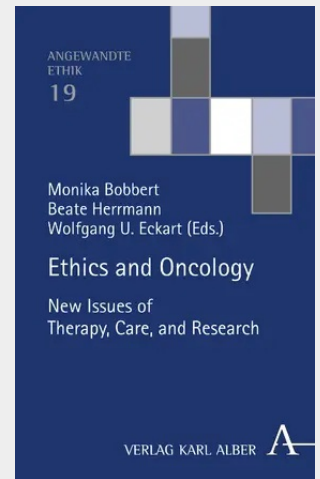


Ethics and Oncology
