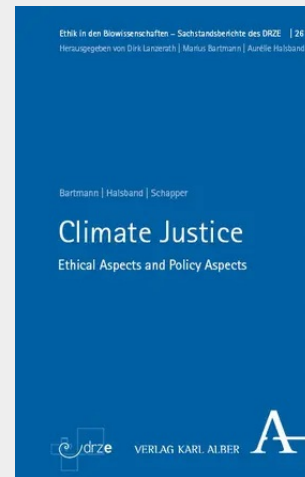


Climate Justice
