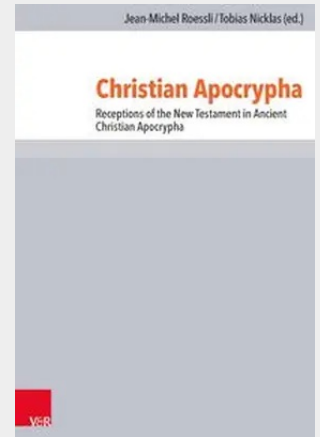
Receptions of the New Testament in Ancient Christian Apocrypha
