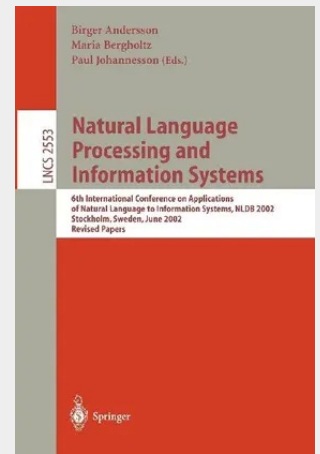


Natural Language Processing and Information Systems

The workshop on Applications of Natural Language to Information Systems (NLDB) has since 1995 provided a forum for academic and industrial researchers and practitioners to discuss the application of natural language to both the development and use of software applications. The use of natural language in relation to software has contributed to improving the development of software from the viewpoints of both the developers and the users. Developers benefit from improvements in conceptual modeling, software validation, natural language program specifications, and many other areas. Users benefit from increased usability of applications through natural language query interfaces, semantic webs, text summarizations, etc. The integration of natural language and information systems has been a long-term search objective for a long time now. Today, the goal of good integration seems not so far-fetched. This is due mainly to the rapid progress of research in natural language and to the development of new and powerful technologies. The integration of natural language and information systems has become a convergent point towards which many researchers from several research areas are focussing.
