

Formal Methods and Software Engineering

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This volume contains the proceedings of the 2003 International Conference on Formal Engineering Methods (ICFEM 2003). The conference was the 5th in a series that began in 1997. ICFEM 2003 was held in Singapore during 5-7 November 2003. ICFEM 2003 aimed to bring together researchers and practitioners from industry, academia, and government to advance the state of the art in formal engineering methods and to encourage a wider uptake of formal methods in industry. The Program Committee received 91 submissions from more than 20 countries in various regions. After each paper was reviewed by at least three referees in each relevant field, 34 high-quality papers were accepted based on originality, technical content, presentation and relevance to formal methods and software engineering.
