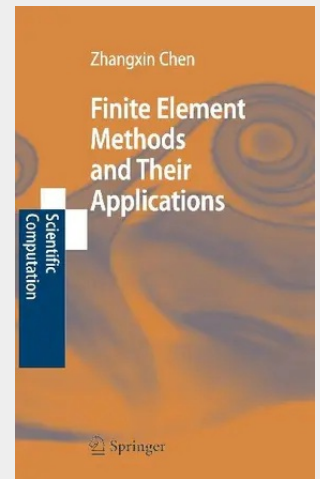


Finite Element Methods and Their Applications
