

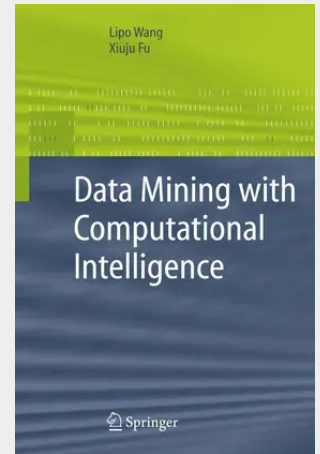
Data Mining with Computational Intelligence
