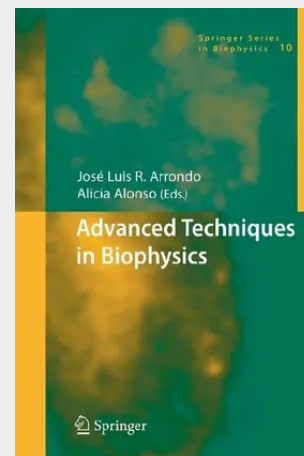


Advanced Techniques in Biophysics
