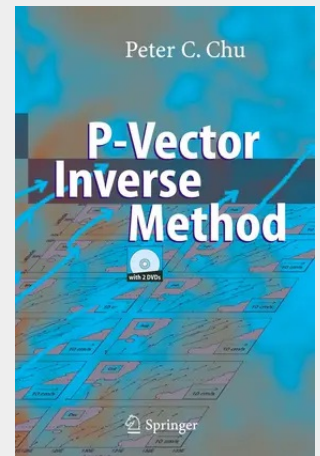


P-Vector Inverse Method
