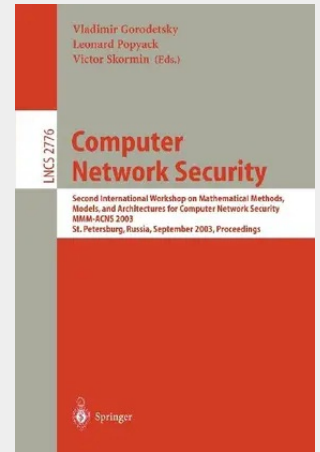


Computer Network Security

Second International Workshop on Mathematical Methods, Models, and Architectures for Computer Network Security, MMM-ACNS 2003, St. Petersburg, Russia, September 21-23, 2003, Proceedings

This volume contains the papers presented at the International Workshop on Mathematical Methods, Models and Architectures for Computer Network Security (MMM-ACNS2003) held in St. Petersburg, Russia, during September 21-23, 2003. The workshop was organized by the St. Petersburg Institute for Informatics and Automation of the Russian Academy of Sciences (SPIIRAS) in cooperation with the Russian Foundation for Basic Research (RFBR), the US Air Force Research Laboratory/Information Directorate (AFRL/IF) and the Air Force Office of Scientific Research (AFOSR), the Office of Naval Research International Field Office (USA), and Binghamton University (SUNY, USA). The first international workshop of this series, MMM-ACNS2001, May 21-23, 2001, St. Petersburg, Russia, hosted by the St. Petersburg Institute for Informatics and Automation, demonstrated the keen interest of the international research community in the theoretical aspects of computer network and information security and encouraged the establishment of an on-going series of biennial workshops. MMM-ACNS2003 provided an international forum for sharing original research results and application experiences among specialists in fundamental and applied problems of computer network security. An important distinction of the workshop was its focus on mathematical aspects of information and computer network security and the role of mathematical issues in contemporary and future development of models of secure computing.

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
