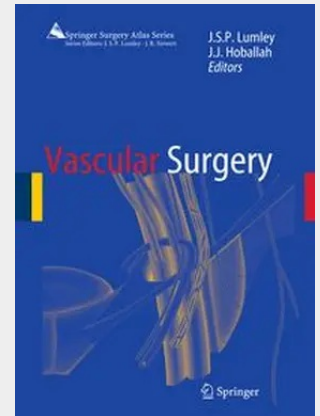


Vascular Surgery

The procedure concludes with a short review of outcome and possible difficulties. The descriptive text is carefully designed to be brief, without sacrificing scientific accuracy.
