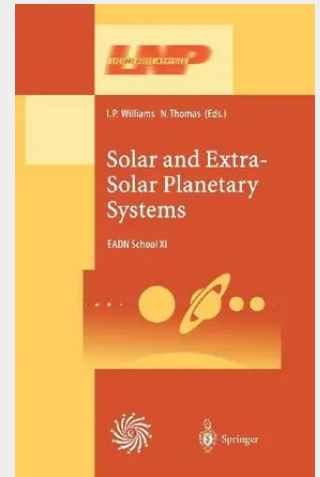


## Solar and Extra-Solar Planetary Systems
