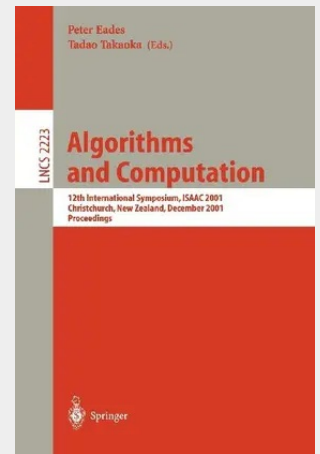


Algorithms and Computation
