

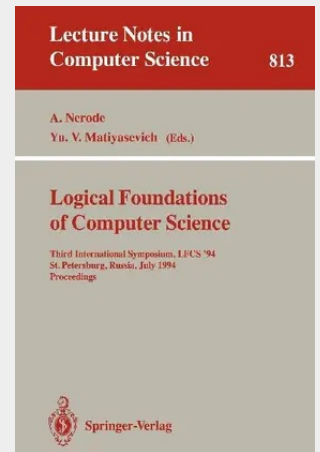
Logical Foundations of Computer Science
