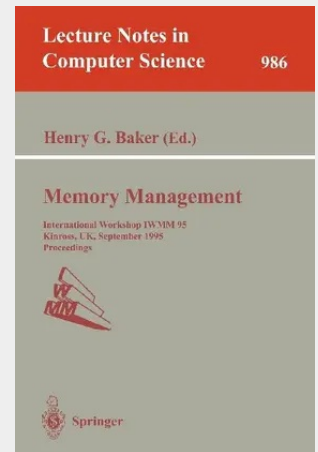


Memory Management
