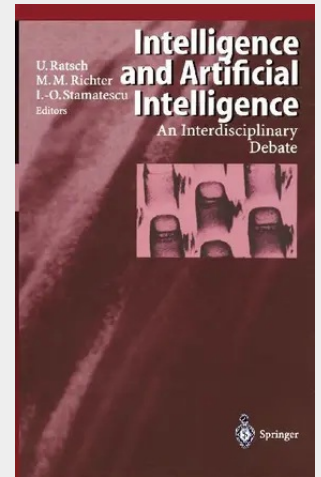


Intelligence and Artificial Intelligence
