

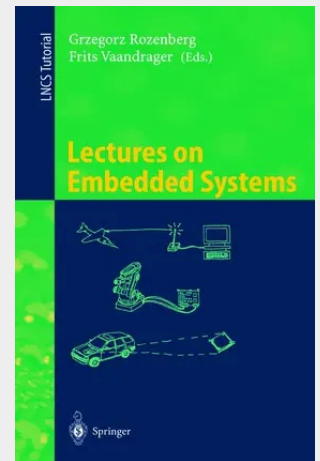
Lectures on Embedded Systems
