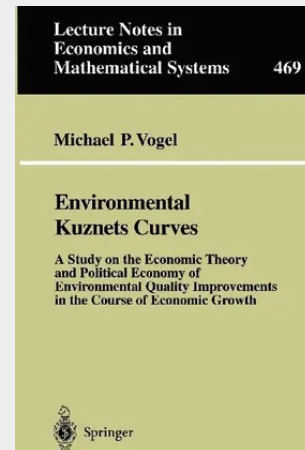


Environmental Kuznets Curves
