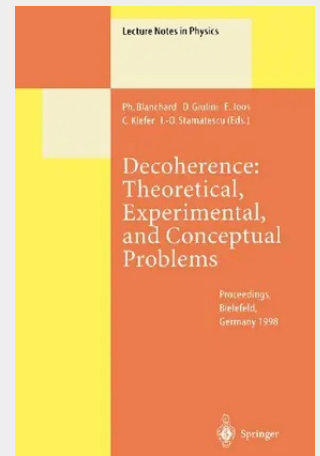


Decoherence: Theoretical, Experimental, and Conceptual Problems
