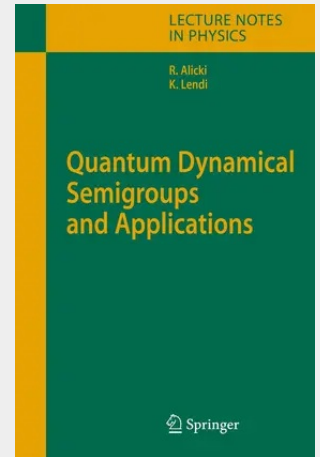


Quantum Dynamical Semigroups and Applications
