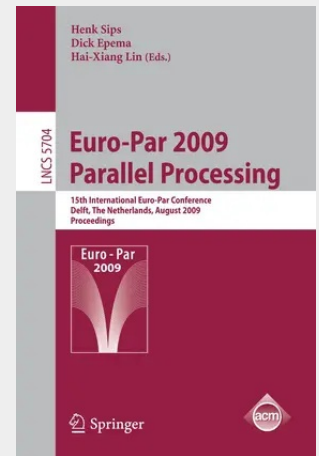


Euro-Par 2009 - Parallel Processing

15th International Euro-Par Conference, Delft, The Netherlands, August 25-28, 2009, Proceedings

Euro-Par is an annual series of international conferences dedicated to the promotion and the advancement of all aspects of parallel computing. In Euro-Par, the field of parallel computing is divided into the four broad categories of theory, high performance, cluster and grid, and distributed and mobile computing. These categories are further subdivided into 14 topics that focus on particular areas in parallel computing. The objective of Euro-Par is to provide a forum for promoting the development of parallel computing both as an industrial technique and as an academic discipline, extending the frontier of both the state of the art and the state of the practice. The target audience of Euro-Par consists of researchers in parallel computing in academic departments, government laboratories, and industrial organizations. Euro-Par 2009 was the 15th conference in the Euro-Par series, and was organized by the Parallel and Distributed Systems Group of Delft University of Technology in Delft, The Netherlands. The previous Euro-Par conferences took place in Stockholm, Lyon, Passau, Southampton, Toulouse, Munich, Manchester, Paderborn, Klagenfurt, Pisa, Lisbon, Dresden, Rennes, and Las Palmas de Gran Canaria.
