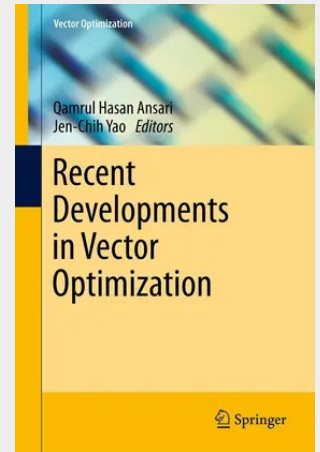


Recent Developments in Vector Optimization
