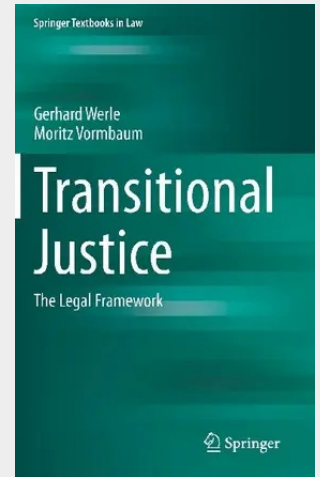
The Legal Framework
