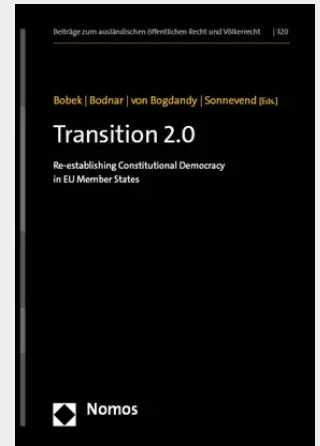


Transition 2.0
