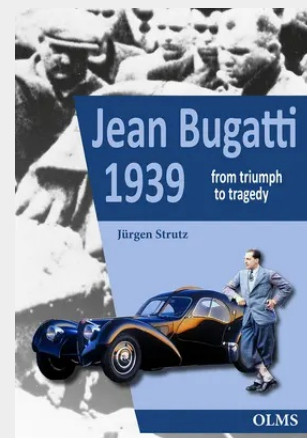


Jean Bugatti 1939
