

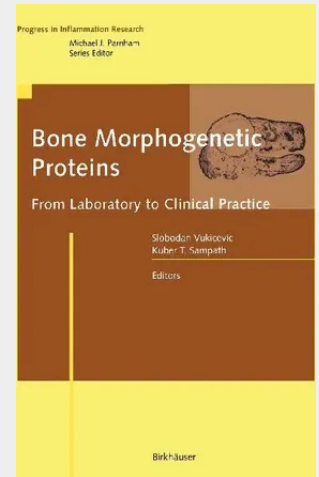
Bone Morphogenetic Proteins
