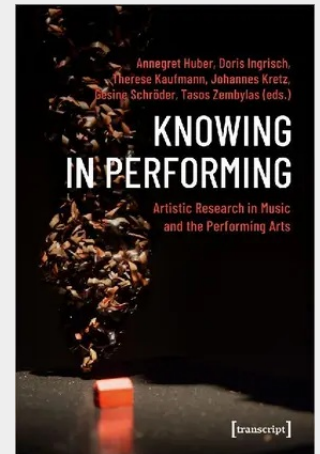


Knowing in Performing
