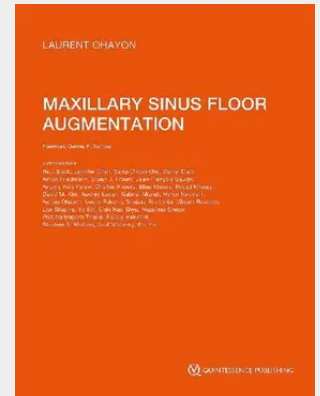


Maxillary Sinus Floor Augmentation
