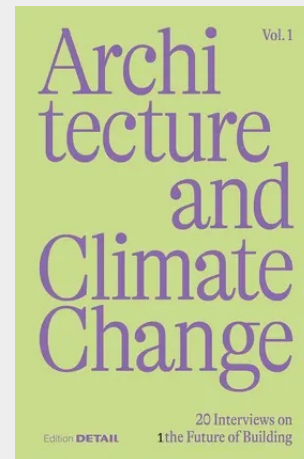


Architecture and Climate Change

Rising temperatures can only be reduced if there is a radical change in the field of construction throughout the world.
