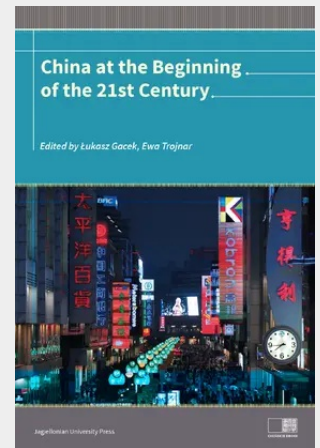


China at the Beginning of the Twenty-First Century
