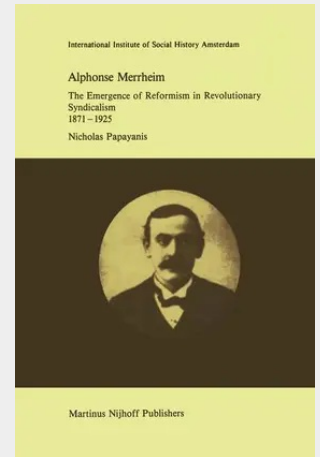

Merrheim is an interesting figure, too, because of his position in the labor movement, for it represents a unique focal point for the study of labor history. Merrheim entered the French labor movement in the 1890s and remained active in it until 1923. During that period he was, successively, a local union leader, co-secretary of a national labor federation, and an important figure within the CGT. Never the secretary-general of the CGT, he was nevertheless the confidant of the secretary-general from 1909, Léon Jouhaux.



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
