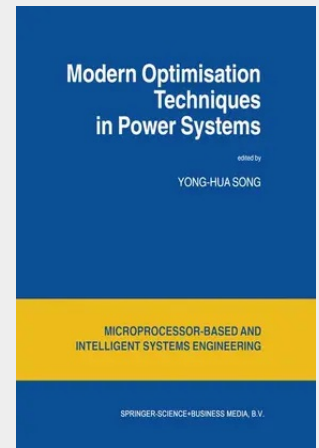


Modern Optimisation Techniques in Power Systems
