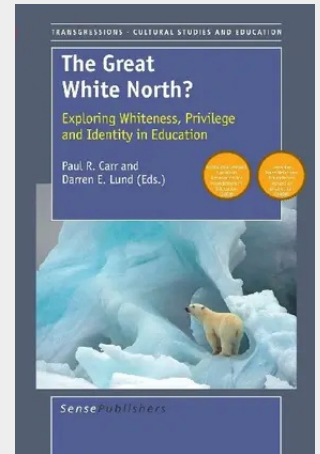


The Great White North?
