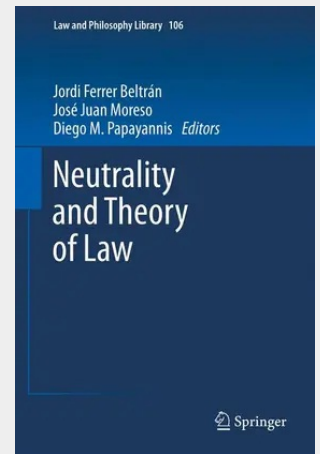


## Neutrality and Theory of Law
