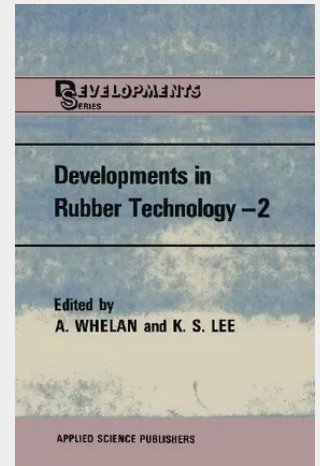


Developments in Rubber Technology-2
