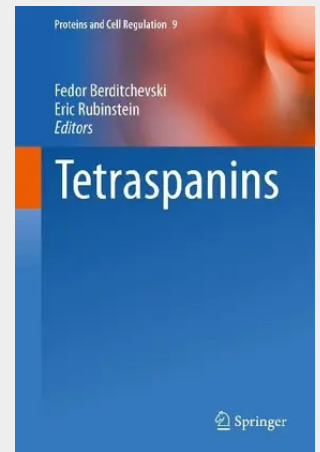


Tetraspanins
