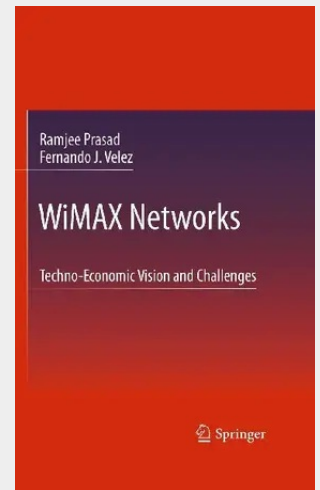


WiMAX Networks
