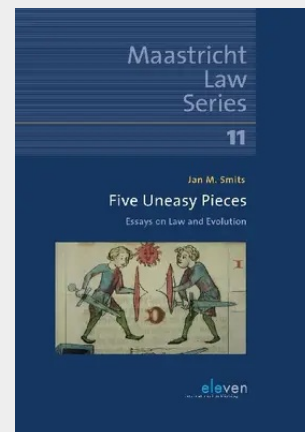


Five Uneasy Pieces
