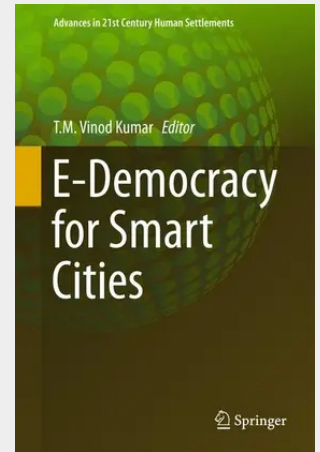


E-Democracy for Smart Cities
